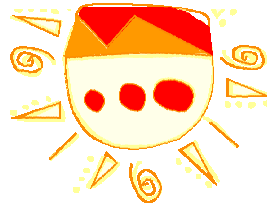


ABOUT SUMMER JAM

KIDS ART CAMP

As part of Summer Jam 2010, Mosaic Connection will be conducting a week long kids art camp. Children in grades 2nd thru 6th, will enjoy five fun filled days full of arts, music, and theater, while developing new relationships and self-esteem. They will start each day with one of several art projects ranging from kaleidoscopes and butterfly baths to chalk pastel drawing and 3-D abstract painting. All led by area artists and Mosaic volunteers. They will break for lunch, which will be provided by Mosaic volunteers. And their days will wind up with group sessions presented by area musicians and entertainers.

The children will also get to be part of a mini theatrical production, led by WACPAC president, Margaret Leatherman, which will be performed at one of Summer Jam's open events, Friday evening, July 30. There will be many areas of involvement from acting to set crew. A great opportunity for the kids to experience theater. *(There may be additional afternoon practices between July 26 and 28. These will be announced.)*

Art Camp will run from July 19-23, 10:00am - 3:00pm, (parent sign-in at 9:45am), with a "Look What I Did" reception, July 23, 6:00 - 8:00pm. This is an open house for the families and friends of the art camp kids to be able to come and see what the children created during the week. Music that evening will be provided by jazz sax musician, Eric Fairhurst. Refreshment will also be provided.

The children's art will remain on display during the final week of Summer Jam, available for pick up the evening of July 30 or 31.

This camp and all materials are provided at no cost by Mosaic Connection to a limit of 25 children. Registration a must and selection will be made on a first come first serve basis.
